From July 28 to August 1, 2025, the **13th** International Russian-Chinese Conference on Deep Geomechanics – Advances in Geomechanics of Highly Compressed Rocks and Masses is being held at FEFU Column Hall on the Russky Island Campus. The **Reports Presentations** in English **should be submitted in advance in pptx format up to July 15** (see Appendix 3). **The Reports can be presented in any of the Conference languages, preferably in English** (without translation).

Hotel

Accommodation for the Conference participants is provided in the International Hotel of the FEFU Campus. Accommodation conditions can be found on the website: https://101hotels.com/main/cities/vladivostok/gostinichniy_kompleks_kampusu_dvfu.html.

Hotel rooms booking would be made in advance through the Organizing Committee of the Conference. Please enter the reservation data in the registration form. It is recommended to book rooms **no later than June 1**, since July is a "hot" month and reservations are limited.

Travel to Hotel

It is possible to reach the Hotel from airport "Knevichy" by an electric train "Aeroexpress" to the City Railway Station and then by taxi. Another one method is to order a taxi directly from the airport by mobile phone, we recommend the popular ordering services "Taxi-Yandex" (tel. 8-423-2010-000) and "Taxi-Maxim" (tel. 8-423-2888-888). Travel to the Campus during the Conference days (in case of accommodation outside the Campus) will be carried out independently: you can get to the Campus by regular buses No. 15, 77 from the "Funicular" stop station or by the taxi.

Publication of Conference Reports

Conference reports approved by the Program Committee will be recommended for publication in the International Journal "**Geohazards Mechanics**", indexed by the Scopus database. In addition, it is planned to publish Abstracts in the Conference Proceedings in printed and electronic form. Abstracts must be sent in electronic form. Rules for the preparation of the

Abstracts see Appendix 2. Publication Fee is included in the Registration Fee. Abstracts will be published before the Conference.

Deadline for the abstracts submission is **June 1**, 2025. The file electronic version must be sent to: conf_ru_cn@mail.ru.

Participation in Conference Events

During the Conference, it is planned to hold a number of Events, including a visit to the FEFU Laboratory of Geomechanics of Highly Compressed Rocks and Masses, a Sports Program in Russian national Sports (Kila – Russian Rugby, Scoringball – Russian Volleyball), as well as a Cultural Program.

Participation in all Events is at the expense of the Conference Participants and is not included in the Registration Fee. Visiting **the Laboratory** and **the Sports Program** do not require expenses.

The Cultural Program includes visits to memorable places in Vladivostok (Vladivostok Fortress, Oceanarium, Opera and Ballet Theater, boat trips, etc.).

Please plan your participation well in advance and enter all selected activities in the Registration Form.

Payment of the Registration Fee

Russian participants Fee is **9000 rubles**, Foreign participants Fee is **¥900**. The registration fee includes all expenses for the Conference (participant's portfolio, coffee breaks, publication of the Program and Abstracts (printed and electronic form), symbols, service). Participants, who make reports on-line, pay an Organizational Fee of **2500 rubles**, Foreign on-line participants Fee is **¥250**, Russian students **1000 rubles**, foreign participants-students **¥100**.

It is preferable to transfer **the registration fee through Sberbank terminals**. Payment details will be sent as a separate notice.

Foreign participants pay the Registration Fee upon arrival at the Conference **before registration**.

RULES FOR ABSTRACTS DESIGN

13th International Russian-Chinese Conference on Geomechanics of Great Depths – Problems of Geomechanics of Highly Compressed Rocks and Masses.

Abstracts are published in the original language (Russian, Chinese) and in English. Abstracts in English are mandatory.

Font - Times New Roman, font size - 11. Line spacing is single. The indentation of the first line is 0.75 cm. Fields: upper, lower, right - 2 cm, left - 3 cm.

Annotation is not more than 300 characters with spaces.

There are no more than 5 keywords.

The abstract text is not more than 5000 characters with spaces.

Information about the authors should include full name, academic degree, position, affiliated organization.

The title should be written in capital letters and aligned in the center.

It is allowed to include no more than 1 b/w picture with a size of no more than 640x480 pixels. The picture format is JPG. The signature is drawn in the form "Figure - Name" and aligned in the center.

Only resulting formulas are given in abstract. Use the built-in Microsoft Word formula editor to create formulas.

Funding sources, as well as acknowledgements, are indicated at the end of the abstract before the list of references.

At the end, no more than 3 references are given. References are indicated in the order of their appearance in the text.

Prepared abstracts should occupy 2 pages of A4 format in both the original language and in English.

Please note that in the event of a significant deviation of the electronic version from the specified recommendations, the Organizing Committee reserves the right not to consider the received abstracts.

RULES FOR PRESENTATION PREPARATION **13th International Russian-Chinese Conference on Deep Geomechanics – Problems of Geomechanics of Highly Compressed Rocks and Masses.**

Presentations are made in **pptx** format **in English**. The first slide contains information about the Conference and the author(s) of the report (name, affiliated organization, position, academic degree and title, country).

On-line Presentations are made in the mode of sounding in one of the languages of the Conference. To do this, you can use the audio recording feature in PowerPoint.

Adding audio record to your presentations:

1. Open an existing or new Presentation.
2. Go to the top toolbar and click Insert.
3. Click "Audio" in the upper right corner and select the "Record" button.
4. Write the name of your audio file.
5. Select the circle symbol when you want to start the recording.

The on-line Presentation recording is **mandatory** and allows to use the time of the report at the Conference as efficiently as possible, as well as to eliminate the inconvenience associated with the large difference in the time zones of the participants.
